## Orthographic Mapping for Spelling Success

Say It • Map It • Remember It

Build strong readers and spellers by connecting sounds, letters, and meaning.

### What is Orthographic Mapping?

Orthographic mapping helps students store words in memory by connecting sounds to letters and meaning.

### Why does it matter?

Students stop guessing and start remembering how words are spelled.

### How to use this page:

1. Say the word
2. Map the sounds
3. Write and use the word

👉 Focus on 3-5 words at a time for best results.



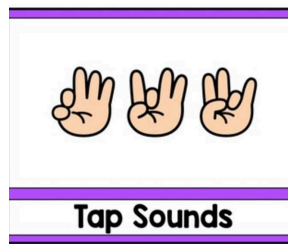
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## Orthographic Mapping - Say It, Tap It, Map It

2. Tap the Sounds

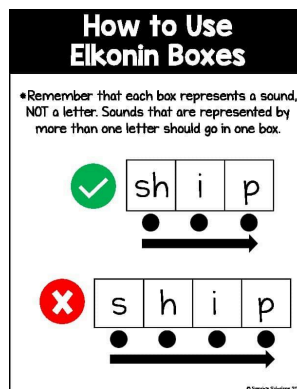
